### **HEAVY HORSE CLASSES**

ENTRIES CLOSE: Monday, August 22nd

- \* The Exhibition commission reserves the privilege of substituting merchandise of equal value for cash in some of the classes.
- \* All Horses must be on the grounds by 9:00 a.m. on Friday, September 16th and remain in stalls until 5:00 p.m. Sunday, September 18th.
- \* All horses must be properly entered on the exhibitor's sheet which is filed at the office. In this way exhibitors can be sure that the horse is being shown in the class in which it was entered and also it saves errors in writing the entry in the judges book.
- \* Entries to be judged must promptly enter the ring when called.
- \* All stall decorations must be left up until 5:00 p.m on Sunday.
- \* Hitch positions must be given to Suzanne Partridge two hours prior to class.
- \* *NO HORSE MAY BE CHANGED FROM ONE SECTION TO ANOTHER AFTER THE EXHIBITION OPENS.*
- \* The classes will be split evenly.
- \* In all purebred classes, the animals exhibited must be registered in the Canadian National Livestock Records, or Association approved by them, and such registration papers properly transferred to the exhibitor. Registration number to be on the entry form. The Registration Certificate of Purebred animals must be checked at the time of judging, and kept available for inspection at ringside. This will be strictly enforced in 2011.
- \* There are to be no vehicles on the grounds after 10:00 a.m. each day. Wagons and carts must be removed before 10:00 a.m. or remain until after 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 18th. Harness boxes are considered as part of the display and therefore must not be removed until 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 18th.
- \* All wagons, carts and harness will be checked to ensure they are considered to be safe. The committee has the right to prevent any horses with unsafe equipment to enter the arena.
- \* **ANY HORSE NOT CONSIDERED SAFE TO BE NEAR LARGE CROWDS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO SHOW IN ANY PERFORMANCE CLASS.**
- \*\*\*PROOF OF LIABILITY INSURANCE: A COPY OF YOUR 2011 NSEF CARD OR A LETTER FROM YOUR INSURANCE COMPANY STATING THAT YOU, THE OWNER, HAVE A MINIMUM OF ONE MILLION DOLLARS IN LIABILITY INSURANCE MUST BE ATTACHED TO YOUR ENTRY FORM. MINIMUM COVERAGE IS ONE MILLION DOLLARS. ALSO - ALL HORSE OWNERS MUST ENSURE THAT DRIVERS, HANDLERS, AND GROOMS ARE ALSO COVERED BY INSURANCE.\*\*\***

### **BREEDING & PAIR CLASSES**

JUDGING TIME FOR ALL LINE CLASSES: Friday, September 16th - See schedule for time.

PRIZE ENTRY FEE: \$60.00 per hitch (includes bedding fee). This includes entry in performance classes. Horses entered in line classes only will be charged \$10.00 per entry per section.

- \* Each team entered entitles exhibitor to two free 3-day passes. Exhibitors requiring additional passes and those exhibitors not paying \$20.00 in prize entry fees will be charged \$20.00 for a 3-day pass.
- \* Animals over 6 months must be registered in the Exhibitor's name.
- \* In Registered Classes animals must be shown in the name of the Registered Owner. Registration papers must be available upon request.
- \* The exhibition shall attempt to supply enough sawdust for bedding for the Exhibitors convenience during their stay at the show.
- \* No stable space for line horses only.

**\* Horses are not permitted to be washed or harnessed in the aisles.\***

## **ARENA PRESENTATION**

THE FOLLOWING POLICY WILL BE IN EFFECT FOR THE 2011 EXHIBITION.

1. There must be two adults on the wagon for all classes (Exception - single horse and ladies cart class). The second adult must be able to assist the driver in the event of an emergency.
2. The person who is not driving will get off the wagon and stand in front of the hitch while the hitch is being judged. (This may be a third person if it is not the person on the wagon.)
3. When hitching in the hitching area there must be one person holding each team. It is preferred that each horse has its own handler.
4. When entering and leaving the arena all hitches MUST WALK.
5. Ladies Cart Class & Jr. Cart Class -- All entries must have headers while the horses are lined up for judging. Enter ring at ringmasters discretion. Every precaution needs to be taken to insure public safety. Your co-operation will be appreciated.

EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATION: Exhibitors are requested to follow advice regarding vaccination from their Veterinarian.

**PLEASE NOTE: Horses to be shown in LINE CLASSES according to the division the team is in. If heavy all horses to be shown heavy - if light all horses are to be shown light).**

24. **Matched Pair, Light**, hitched to vehicle. MAN OR LADY DRIVER
25. **Matched Pair, Heavy**, hitched to vehicle. MAN OR LADY DRIVER
26. **Men's Cart**. EACH HORSE CAN GO IN ONLY ONE CART CLASS.
27. **Working Class** ( Team) This class will be a team class hooked to a wagon. Exhibitors will be required to do a pattern for this class. This will be one class for all breeds.
28. **Unicorn Hitch** - Three horses hitched to vehicle , not necessarily owned by one exhibitor, one driver and one assistant on wagon.
29. **Four Horse Hitch** - Not necessarily one owner, but each pair one owner. Driver and one assistant only on wagon. - **\$80, \$70, \$60, \$50**
30. **Six Horse Hitch** - Not necessarily one owner, but each pair one owner. Driver and one assistant only on wagon. - **\$120, \$100, \$90, \$80**

**BRISON DEVELOPMENTS PRESENTS:**

**Championship Six Horse Hitch. Class to follow immediately after last six horse hitch class. The first place entries of each breed will compete in the Championship Class. Prize Money: \$150, \$90, \$60**

**ALL BREED CLASSES**

**Section 31 - 33 Prize Money - \$17, \$15, \$13, \$10**

31. **Junior Driving** (boys and girls under 16 years as of Jan. 1/11). Junior must be accompanied by an adult.
32. **Ladies Driving** (over 16 years.) This will be a driving class where the Exhibitor will be required to do a simple pattern. Drive around the ring and cut one to two figure eights. No backing, fanning, etc. will be required for Juniors. Ladies may be asked to back their team and fan.
33. **Junior Cart Class** (driver to be 16 years or younger as of Jan. 1/11). Junior must be accompanied by an adult.
34. **Ladies Two Wheel Cart Class**. EACH HORSE CAN GO IN ONLY ONE CART CLASS. To be judged fit for a lady. Manners of horse 40% (suitable for a lady), 30% conformation, 30% performance. Ladies' Cart Class sponsored by **CelticCuts (Letitia Deemer - Owner) - \$25, \$20, \$17, \$15, \$12, \$10**
