Three horses and riders (previously booked) will leave Fort Edward, home of the first fair in 1765 to join up with the parade. The Town Crier will officially open of the 250th anniversary year of the Hants County Exhibition at the close of the parade. Please meet at **10:00am** in the general parking lot off Centennial Drive (by the Irving). Someone will meet and direct you to parking and line up area. Rain or shine!

If you are including livestock or animals in your exhibit, we encourage you to only bring livestock or pets that are quiet, well behaved and used to busy environments. We reserve the right to refuse any entry if deemed unsuitable or unsafe. A waiver will be provided at point of entry to be signed by an adult or parent of participants under 18. Anyone driving must have a valid driver's license, valid vehicle registration and proof of insurance. Children must wear helmets if riding.
