### **HEAVY HORSE CLASSES**

**COMMITTEE:** Leon Taylor, Lawrence Boyd, Brian Casey, Suzanne Partridge and Sandi Powell.

**ENTRIES CLOSE:** August 26th

- \* The Exhibition commission reserves the privilege of substituting merchandise of equal value for cash in some of the classes.
- \* All Horses must be on the grounds by 8:00 a.m. on Friday, September 13th and remain in stalls until 5:00 p.m. Sunday, September 15th.
- \* All horses must be properly entered on the exhibitor's sheet which is filed at the office. In this way exhibitors can be sure that the horse is being shown in the class in which it was entered and also it saves errors in writing the entry in the judges book.
- \* Entries to be judged must promptly enter the ring when called.
- \* All stall decorations must be left up until 5:00 p.m on Sunday.
- \* Hitch positions must be given to Suzanne Partridge two hours prior to class.
- \* *NO HORSE MAY BE CHANGED FROM ONE SECTION TO ANOTHER AFTER THE EXHIBITION OPENS.*
- \* The classes will be split evenly.
- \* In all purebred classes, the animals exhibited must be registered in the Canadian National Livestock Records, or Association approved by them, and such registration papers properly transferred to the exhibitor. Registration number to be on the entry form. The Registration Certificate of Purebred animals must be checked at the time of judging, and kept available for inspection at ringside. This will be strictly enforced in 2019.
- \* There are to be no vehicles on the grounds after 10:00 a.m. each day. Wagons and carts must be removed before 10:00 a.m. or remain until after 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 15th. Harness boxes are considered as part of the display and therefore must not be removed until 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 15th.
- \* All wagons, carts and harness will be checked to ensure they are considered to be safe. The committee has the right to prevent any horses with unsafe equipment to enter the arena.
- \* ANY HORSE NOT CONSIDERED SAFE TO BE NEAR LARGE CROWDS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO SHOW IN ANY PERFORMANCE CLASS.

**\*\*\*PROOF OF LIABILITY INSURANCE: A COPY OF YOUR 2019 NSEF CARD OR A LETTER FROM YOUR INSURANCE COMPANY STATING THAT YOU, THE OWNER, HAVE A MINIMUM OF ONE MILLION DOLLARS IN LIABILITY INSURANCE MUST BE ATTACHED TO YOUR ENTRY FORM. ALSO - ALL HORSE OWNERS MUST ENSURE THAT DRIVERS, HANDLERS, AND GROOMS ARE ALSO COVERED BY INSURANCE.\*\*\***

### **BREEDING & PAIR CLASSES**

**JUDGING TIME FOR ALL LINE CLASSES:** Friday, September 13th - 8:30 a.m. in the Dexter/Mary Henry Bldg

**PRIZE ENTRY FEE:** \$80.00 per team (includes bedding fee). This includes entry in performance classes.

Horses entered in line classes only will be charged \$10.00 per entry per section and if stalls are available they can request to stay the weekend by paying another \$10.00 for a stall which includes bedding..

- \* Each team entered entitles exhibitor to two free 3-day passes. Exhibitors requiring additional passes and those exhibitors paying under \$80.00 in prize entry fees can purchase a 3-day exhibitor's pass for \$25.00.
- \* Animals over 6 months must be registered in the Exhibitor's name.
- \* In Registered Classes animals must be shown in the name of the Registered Owner. Registration papers must be available upon request.
- \* The exhibition shall attempt to supply enough sawdust for bedding for the Exhibitors convenience during their stay at the show.

**\* Horses are not permitted to be washed or harnessed in the aisles.\***

## **ARENA PRESENTATION**

### **THE FOLLOWING POLICY WILL BE IN EFFECT FOR THE EXHIBITION.**

- Owners, drivers and handlers must, at all times, handle and drive horses in a safe and prudent manner with the safety of the public and other exhibitors in mind.
- When entering and leaving the ring all hitches MUST WALK.
- There must be ONLY 2 people (both capable of driving in case of an emergency) on the wagon at all times when the wagon is in motion (Exception: Single Horse and Ladies Cart Class)
- When the wagons (all Hitches over a team hitch) are lined up in the show ring a THIRD PERSON must come in to be the header for each hitch.
- Ladies Cart Class and – All entries must have a header when lined up in the ring.
- Junior Team Driver Class and Junior Cart Class must be accompanied by a capable driver over the age of 18 years. - **Juniors are required to wear a Hard Protective Hat/Helmet.**
- When hitching in the hitching area each horse must have a handler who is covered by Liability Insurance. When hitching it is further required to have one person on the wagon who is a capable driver.
- When entering the show ring drivers are to drive across the ring and make a left turn.
- Horses must be well broke to drive as single, team and in multiple hitches.

EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATION: Exhibitors are requested to follow advice regarding vaccination from their Veterinarian.

22. Matched Pair, Light, hitched to vehicle. MAN OR LADY DRIVER

23. Matched Pair, Heavy, hitched to vehicle. MAN OR LADY DRIVER

24. Men's Cart – all breed.

25. Unicorn Hitch - Three horses hitched to vehicle, not necessarily owned by one exhibitor, one driver and one assistant on wagon.

26. Four Horse Hitch - Not necessarily one owner, but each pair one owner. Driver and one assistant only on wagon. – Prize Money \$92, \$81, \$70

27. Championship Four Horse Hitch: All breed. Class to follow immediately after last four horse hitch class. Open to all entries of the preceding breed classes. Prize Money: \$150, \$90, \$60

28. Six Horse Hitch - One class - All breed. Not necessarily one owner, but each pair one owner. Driver and one assistant only on wagon. - \$240, \$200, \$180, \$150

**GFL ENVIROMENTAL \$1,000.00 8 HORSE HITCH**

29. Eight Horse Hitch – all breed - will follow the last 6 horse hitch class as per schedule.

**ALL BREED CLASSES**

Section 30 - 32 Prize Money - \$25, \$20, \$15,

30. Junior Driving (boys and girls 16 years or younger as of Jan. 1/19). Junior must be accompanied by an adult.

31. Ladies Driving (over 16 years.) This will be a driving class where the Exhibitor will be required to do a simple pattern; no fanning.

32. Junior Cart Class (driver to be 16 years or younger as of Jan. 1/19). Junior must be accompanied by an adult.

**LADIES CART CLASS**

33. Ladies Two Wheel Cart Class – all breed. To be judged fit for a lady. Manners of horse 40% (suitable for a lady), 30% conformation, 30% performance. Prize money: \$50, \$45, \$40, \$35, \$30, \$25

\* Entries in Ladies Cart Class must be given to Suzanne Partridge by 12:00 noon on Saturday.
