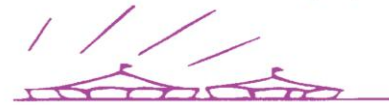

## **SENIOR GYMKHANA - M.B.R.A. RULES WILL APPLY**

**SHOW MANAGER:** Lisa Hines

- All competitors must report to show office before showing.
- Horses must be walked into the ring. Riders will be given a signal to enter the ring, no further signal will be given.
- Horses must be walked from the ring to exercise area.
- Riders are not permitted to exercise more than one horse at a time (no ponying).
- Both hands may be used on reins. 5 second penalty for knocking down barrel or pole.
- Handlers must release horses at in-gate.
- If a horse or rider (or both) fall during a run it is considered off course and thus eliminates them from that run.

**ENTRIES:** All entries must be on the regulation form provided. See top of entry form for mailing address and phone/fax numbers. Entries may be paid for with cash, cheque or VISA/MASTERCARD. We can also accept e-transfers. Please use **MBRA19** as the password for the e-transfer.

**ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNTIL PAID IN FULL**

**CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES:** Entries must be received by the office on or before August 26th.

**NOTE:** Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry due to lack of stabling and/or scheduling.

**REFUNDS:** Will be made with Vet Certificate prior to the first class. To collect, vet certificate must be given to the show office. A refund will be made on drug fee, stake fee and 75% of entry fee.

**LIABILITY INSURANCE:** Third-party Liability Insurance is required.

**EXHIBITORS MUST INCLUDE WITH ENTRY A CURRENT LETTER FROM THEIR INSURANCE COMPANY STATING THAT THEY HAVE ONE MILLION DOLLARS (MINIMUM) LIABILITY COVERAGE WHILE ATTENDING THE HANTS COUNTY EXHIBITION OR PROOF OF MEMBERSHIP IN NSEF.**

**STABLING:** Entries in the Open Gymkhana must arrive between the hours of 6:00 pm Thursday, September 12th and 11:00 am on Friday, September 13th. They must remain stabled on the grounds until 5:00 p.m. Sunday, September 15th. See Schedule for class times.

**Open Gymkhana** must pay \$50.00 for a box stall for the weekend.

**Campers/Trailers:** \$20.00 per night.

### **CAMPER/RV INFO**

There will be construction happening in our parking lot in 2019. This will lead to positive change going forward but will require a little understanding and patience in 2019, so please bear with us.

All exhibitors wishing to bring campers and RVs for exhibition, to be used for living accommodations, will be parked in various locations on the grounds. We cannot guarantee services in all locations so please be prepared to operate un-serviced if necessary. Spots will be issued on a first come first serve basis. We will need your information by August 27. Please include what division you are showing in (4H, gymkhana etc), dates, length of your trailer, planned drop off time, best number for contact.

**\*\*Please note camping may be limited to exhibitors only\***

All livestock trailers will be parked offsite in designated parking areas. Exhibitors will be allowed access to the barns to drop off hay, etc. prior to 10 AM.

**SPECIAL CAMPER TRAILER PARKING INSTRUCTIONS**

**NO CAMPER TRAILERS** are to be parked in the regular trailer parking area without supervision. Trailers may be delivered to the grounds early and temporarily parked in a designated holding area and then parked with supervision during the specific times listed below.

**SUPERVISED HOURS ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

Tentative schedule: September 8 – 3 pm to 8 pm & September 12 and 13th - 8 am to 8 pm  
& September 19th and 20th - 8 am to 8 pm

**ENTRY FEE:** \$65.00 for Pole Bending plus \$10.00 stake fee per class = \$95.00  
\$65.00 for Barrel Race. Total \$160.00 for the 6 classes.

**PRIZE MONEY:** Pole Bending prize money will be mailed following the Exhibition.

**DRUG TESTING FEE:** There is a \$5.00 mandatory drug fee charged to every MBRA competitor.
