ENTRIES: One wishing to enter work in Class E should obtain an entry form by coming to the HANTS COUNTY EXHIBITION office between 8 am and 4 pm weekdays OR by downloading the form from the Website. **Those wishing to enter in the Arts & Crafts division must bring their completed entry form with the article they wish to enter to the Exhibition Crafts Department between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. or 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 13th.** You will then be able to enter your article for competition. Local Exhibitors are urged to visit the Exhibition Office and pick up tags to speed up the entering process. The Committee reserves the right to limit number of articles for display based upon space availability. Each exhibitor is urged to pick up items **at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 24th. Please be sure you have your exhibitor's part of your tag for identification purposes.**

RULES:

ONE ENTRY PER SECTION PER EXHIBITOR

- All entries must be the work of the exhibitor from the start to finish with the exception of printing and developing of photographs.
- All artwork should be original, suitably framed and mounted to enable display. **PLEASE ATTACH WIRE to the back of the paintings for hanging purposes.** No string saw hangers or tape because it is not sturdy enough to hold paintings.
- Paintings entered for competition must have been completed in the previous 12 month period. Any artwork previously entered will be refused.
- All painting must be original, not to exceed 24" x 36" including framing.

Note - Drawings, etchings, etc. must be mounted and wire attached so it will be possible to hang.

NOTE: Write in the media (oil, pastel or acrylic) not the name of painting on the tag.

Handcraft items are to be no larger than 12" in height or 12" in width due to display space.

RULES

IMPORTANT: ANY PERSON WHO HAS RECEIVED PAYMENT FOR THEIR PHOTOGRAPHY WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED AN AMATEUR AND THEREFORE THESE ENTRIES WILL BE REFUSED. Photos must have been taken in the past 12 months. No repeat entries.

The printing and developing is optional. NO DARK ROOM SPECIAL WORK IS TO BE DONE.

No studio photographs will be accepted. Digital photos properly printed on photo quality paper will be accepted. All exhibits must be mounted on card stock or similar material, no mounting on plastic, thick cardboard, foam and no commercial matting.

ALL PHOTOS MUST HAVE ½ inch BORDER AROUND THEM. Photos are not to exceed 4" x 6".

Staples are **not to be used** when attaching entry tags to photos as they will scratch other photos. Entries of exhibitors using staples will not be accepted.
