

CLASS D - HANTS COUNTY EXHIBITION FLOWER SHOW

Exhibitors are not required to send an entry form in advance. The Committee will be accepting exhibits for the Flower judging between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 12th. Each exhibitor will be required to fill out an entry form and tags for their exhibit at that time.

The Committee will provide the required containers. Be sure of the count. Judge will be instructed to withhold prizes from exhibitors of inferior merit or where correct number of flower is not contained in exhibit. **THE DECISION OF THE JUDGE IS FINAL.** Members of the Committee have nothing to do with the judging. **Two entries per class are permitted.**

All exhibits will be judged commencing at 9:00 a.m. Friday, September 13th. Exhibits must remain in place until 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 22nd. Prizes will be available from the Committee commencing at 5:00 p.m. September 22nd.

THE BEST OVERALL FLOWER ENTRY WILL RECEIVE THE GERT LAWRENCE MEMORIAL TROPHY.

SECTION - Remove foliage below waterline and no buds (except on stalks). Please Note: Leaves should be left attached to all Dahlias, but no buds

1. Nasturtium, single, 5 blooms, mixed or one colour
2. Pansy, 5 blooms, mixed
3. Marigold, French, medium, 5 blooms, one variety
4. Marigold, any other variety, 5 blooms, properly named
5. Any other variety of flower, 5 stems, correctly named
6. Zinnia, any variety, single stem, properly named
7. Lavatera, 5 stalks, mixed or one colour (should include buds)
8. Petunias, single, 5 blooms mixed or one colour
9. Petunias, any other variety, 5 blooms, properly named, mixed or one colour
10. Asters, any variety, 5 blooms, mixed or one colour
11. Any other variety garden flower (not mentioned), on 3 separate stems, mixed or one colour, correctly named
12. Dahlia, Decorative, informal - over 6 inches, 2 blooms only, mixed or one colour
13. Dahlia, Decorative, formal, 4" and under, 3 blooms, mixed or one colour
14. Dahlia, Decorative, formal, 4" and over, 3 blooms, mixed or one colour - no buds
15. Dahlia, any other variety, 3 blooms, properly named, mixed or one colour
16. Dahlia, largest bloom, single bloom, any variety, properly named, mixed or one colour
17. Rose Bowl, one rose (not a miniature), bloom open
18. Hybrid T-Roses with foliage, 5 blooms, mixed or one colour
19. Hybrid T-Rose, 1 bloom only
20. Roses, Floribunda, Polyantha or shrub, 3 sprays, mixed or one colour
21. Calendulas, mixed or one colour, 3 or 5 stalks, includes leaves and buds
22. Cosmos, 5 stalks with buds, mixed or one colour - leave some foliage
23. Glads, single stalk
24. Glads, 3 stalks, mixed
25. Glads, 3 stalks, 1 colour
26. Grasses, 3 stems
27. Best Sunflower, 1 stalk with 1 bloom (not to be cross entered with vegetable show)
28. Best Sunflower, 1 stalk with multiple blooms (not to be cross entered with vegetable show)
29. Sedums, 3 stalks
30. Dark Eyed Susan's, 3 stalks, Rudbeckia hirta – larger flower heads
- 30A Dark Eyed Susan's, 3 stalks, Rudbeckia fulgida, Goldsturm, narrow, glossy leaves

BEST POTTED HOUSE PLANTS (may be summered outside) - POTS NOT TO EXCEED 10" grown by exhibitor – not direct from store

House Plants (Cactus) MUST BE GROWN BY THE EXHIBITOR.

31. Cactus, any variety, properly named
32. Cactus or Succulent Rock Garden, not to exceed 12" in diameter - 4 or more in 1 dish - with or without accessories.

House Plants (Foliage) MUST BE GROWN BY THE EXHIBITOR.

33. Trailing or vine plant, Philodendron, Ivy, etc.
34. Fern

36. Any other foliage plant not mentioned (correctly named)
37. Geranium (Pelargonium) flowering
38. Wax Begonia, flowering
39. Any other flowering plant not mentioned (correctly named)
40. African Violet, single crown, single or double bloom
41. African Violet, miniature
42. Streptocarpus – stemless
- 42A Streptocarpella - stemmed
43. Most unusual plant - indoor or outdoor (correctly named)
