JUDGING: Thursday, September 17th.

ENTRIES: One wishing to enter work in Class E should obtain an entry form by coming to the Hants County Exhibition office between 8 am and 4 pm weekdays or downloading the entry form from the website. **Those wishing to enter in the Arts & Crafts division must bring their completed entry form with the article they wish to enter to the Exhibition Crafts Department between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. or 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 16th.** You will then be able to enter your article for competition. Local Exhibitors are urged to visit the Exhibition Office and pick up tags to speed up the entering process. This may be done during regular office hours Monday through Friday. The Committee reserves the right to limit number of articles for display based upon space availability. **Each exhibitor is urged to pick up items at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 27th.** Please be sure you have your exhibitor's part of your tag for identification purposes.

RULES:

- ONE ENTRY PER NUMBER PER EXHIBITOR

- All entries must be the work of the exhibitor from the start to finish with the exception of printing and developing of photographs.
- All artwork should be original, suitably framed and mounted to enable display. **PLEASE ATTACH WIRE to the back of the paintings for hanging purposes. No string, saw hangers or tape because it is not sturdy enough to hold paintings**
- Paintings entered for competition must have been completed in the previous 12 month period.
- Any artwork previously entered will be refused.
- All painting must be original, not to exceed 24" x 36" including framing.

*****PLEASE NOTE: ALL FRAMED WORK MUST HAVE WIRE ON BACK FOR HANGING – NO EXCEPTIONS*****

NOTE: WRITE IN THE MEDIA (OIL, PASTEL OR ACRYLIC) NOT THE NAME OF PAINTING on the tag,

Handcraft items except wreaths and scarecrows are to be no larger than 12" in height or 12" in width due to display space.
